COLORS AVAILABLE: Deep Yellow, Orange, Red, Yellow, Purple-Red, Purple-Orange, Yellow- Red
SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 5 - 7" / Annual
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Compact and uniform; big fruit on top of plants; solid and multicolor varieties; long shelf life; extreme heat tolerance
MARKET USE: Bedding, pot; mixed containers; excellent for mid- to late-summer production

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:
 SOWING: 288 cell tray
 FINISH CONTAINER: 1 plant per pot in 3.5" – 6" pot; 3 plants per pot in 8" pot
PLUG STAGE:
 GERMINATION: Emergence 10 – 12 days / 68 - 72°F
 PLUG FINISH: 5 - 6 weeks in a 288 tray
FINISHING:
 TRANSPLANT: 5 – 6 weeks after sowing
 DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER SOWING: 15 – 20 weeks (depending on night temperatures)
 TEMPERATURE: 68 - 90°F day / 60 - 70°F night
 EC: 1.5 – 2.0 mS/cm (pour thru method)
 PH: 5.5 – 6.0

COMMON DISEASE/PEST: Aphids, thrips, whitefly
GARDEN: Full sun, well-drained soil

NOTES:

- Important to let the plants dry out in between watering; never overwater
- Ornamental peppers are sensitive to oil based pesticides; some phytotoxicity has been observed under high light conditions
- PGRs not necessary on Mambo
