

Hybrid Onion Mountaineer (T 422)



DESCRIPTION: Early/mid, long day, Northeastern type

MATURITY: Early maturing (95-100 days)

COMPARABLE VARIETIES: Millennium, Barrage, and Hamlet

VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS: This early/mid Northeastern long-day onion is comparable to Millennium, Barrage and Hamlet. Bulbs are flattened globe in shape and have excellent skin quality. The outstanding features to this variety are its earliness and storability. With thinner necks, this onion cures down quickly for excellent storage results. Mountaineer will store slightly longer than Frontier.
