| DESCRIPTION: | Apollo has moderate head height, with a weight of approximately 5.5 lbs. Bright green external color, light yellow internal color. Suitable for harvest spring to early summer. |
| MATURITY: | Approximately 65 days after sowing |

| VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS: | This variety has excellent field holding ability with a strong tolerance to heat, moderate cold tolerance. High resistance to Clubroot. |

FEATURES

Note: Chinese Cabbage requires vernalization. Bud differentiation and bolting results from low temperatures of 5°C for a week or 10°C for two weeks. For spring harvest, transplant seedlings with 5-7 true leaves raised at 23-24°C during the day and over 12°C at night. Providing plants with adequate water and fertilizer after transplanting will promote faster growth.
