COLORS AVAILABLE: Bronze, Cream Yellow, Deep Orange, Light Pink, Light Salmon, Pink, Purple, Velvet,

White, Yellow

SIZE/PLANT HABIT/TYPE: 36 to 40 inches / slightly branching stems/annual, Group I -II

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Peloric (open-face) type, uniformity, sweet scent

SOWING: Fall (August – October)

FINISH: Late Fall, Winter, early Spring

PLUG STAGE:

TRAY SIZE: 512, 288

GERMINATION: 7 to 14 days after sowing

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Not required

PLUG FINISH TIME: 28 to 35 days

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 30 to 40 days after sowing

SPACING: 5- to 6-inches with support netting

DAYS TO FLOWER: 100-110 days from sowing

pH: 6.5-7.0

COMMON DISEASES/PESTS: Botrytis, Powdery Mildew, Pythium, Rhizoctania/Aphids, Thrips, Spider mites,

Whitefly

NOTES:

Cut with 8 to 10 buds open

Store upright in water (with preservative) as horizontal stems turn upward
