



Bunching Onion Ishikura Improved



DESCRIPTION: Medium early, single stalk variety. White stem has the length of approximately 20-24 inches and is glossy and very compact. Leaf color is a very attractive deep green.

GROWING POINTS: Avoid sowing too early to reduce likelihood of bolting. Recommended bed width is approximately . 32-36 inches, plant space will be approximately 1 to1.5 inches.

VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS: Due to its tolerance to cooler temperatures, Ishikura Improved is suitable for winter harvesting. This variety has an upright plant habit with 6-7 leaves per plant. Its leaves are thick compared to other varieties. Neck is tight and uniform making it ideal for packing and bunching.

ADAPTABILITY: Recommended summer to fall sowing on the East Coast, and winter sowing is recommended in the Sunbelt areas.
