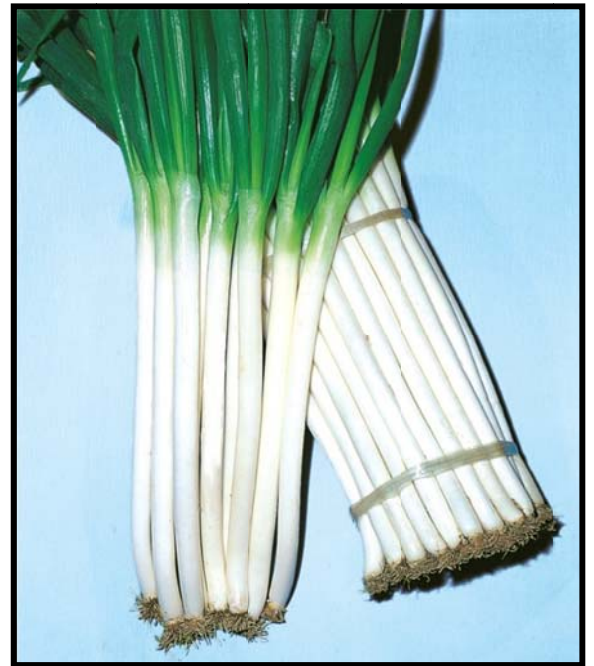


Bunching Onion Feast



DESCRIPTION: Single stalk variety. White stem has the length of approximately 16 to 20 inches and is glossy and very compact. Leaf color is deep green. Upright plant habit, 7-8 leaves per plant and thicker compared to other varieties.

GROWING POINTS: Avoid sowing too early to reduce likelihood of bolting. Recommended bed width is approximately 32-36 inches, plant space will be approximately 1 to 1.5 inches.

CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS: Tolerant to heat stress, resistant to Downy mildew and Alternaria leaf spot. Neck is tight and uniform making it ideal for packing and bunching. Recommended for spring to summer production.
