COLOR: Foliar grass plant with pale bronze, finely textured leaves

SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 12 inches / hardy evergreen perennial, USDA 6 to 9

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Clumping sedge forms arching mound

MARKET USE: Excellent for landscape, containers, and low maintenance gardens

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 200 - 128 cell tray, multiple sow for best plug

FINISH CONTAINER: Quart, 6" pot, gallon and larger

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 2 - 5 weeks / 70 - 72°F, do not cover seed

PLUG FINISH: 8 - 16 weeks after sowing from plug

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: One per quart, 1 to 3 per gallon

DAYS TO FINISH AFTER 22 – 26 weeks

SOWING: 22 20 V

TEMPERATURE: 70 - 75°F average temperature

GARDEN: Grow in sun to part shade in a well-drained location

NOTES:

• Best sow dates are November to March, for late spring sales sow in December or January
