



# Hybrid Collard Hi-Crop



DESCRIPTION:	Medium plant size with an upright habit. Deep green semi-savoy leaves have smooth, rounded leaf margins. Best adapted to spring harvest season. Good taste, suitable for processing.
MATURITY:	Medium early, 80 days maturity post-transplant
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Flash, Top Bunch
CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS:	Hi-Crop has high tolerance to premature bolting. Plant habit will remain open with cold temperatures while competitive varieties tend to close in (cupping). Consistent for type with uniform plant size and leaf size distribution.
