Digitalis x hybrida



COLOR:	Vibrant rose-pink with speckled throat
SIZE/PLANT HABIT:	Height: 18 - 22 inches / Annualized perennial
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:	Compact and uniform; heavily branching plants produce multiple flower spikes at one time, long lasting blooms, first year flowering
MARKET USE:	Bedding, pot, mixed container

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS

PLUG STAGE

SOWING: 288 tray, one seed per cell

GERMINATION: 10 to 12 days / 60 to 65°F

PLUG FINISH: 5 to 6 weeks / 68 to 70°F

FINISHING

CONTAINER SIZE: Gallon - 1 plant per pot

TEMPERATURE: Day: 65 to 70°F / Night: 55 to 65°F (warmer temperatures will give faster finish)

WEEKS TO FINISH: Long Day: 13 weeks sow to finish; 7 weeks from plug to finish

Short Day: 18 to 20 weeks sow to finish; 12 to 14 weeks from plug to finish

EC: 1.0 - 1.5 mmhos/cm

pH: 5.8 - 6.2

COMMON DISEASES/PESTS: Aphids, thrips

GROWTH REGULATORS: None needed

NOTES:

- No vernalization needed
- Sterile, not self-seeding
- Long flowering period
- Winter hardy to USDA Zone 5, with cover
