

Hybrid Chinese Cabbage Monument



DESCRIPTION:	Medium green outer leaves with white internal color, crisp leaves with head height approximately 18 inches (45 centimeters) and weight approximately 4.5 lbs (2.0 kgs).
MATURITY:	Approximately 80 days after sowing
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Michihili types
VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:	Monument has moderate tolerance to heat and cold, and moderate resistance to many diseases. Recommended fall to winter harvest.
ADAPTABILITY:	Most Chinese Cabbage growing areas

FEATURES

- Good resistance to diseases
- Good resistance to heat and cold

BENEFITS

- Reduced disease pressure
- Wide adaptability

Note: Chinese Cabbage requires vernalization. Bud differentiation and bolting results from low temperatures of 5°C for a week or 10°C for two weeks. For spring harvest, transplant seedlings with 5-7 true leaves raised at 23-24°C during the day and over 12°C at night. Providing plants with adequate water and fertilizer after transplanting will promote faster growth.
