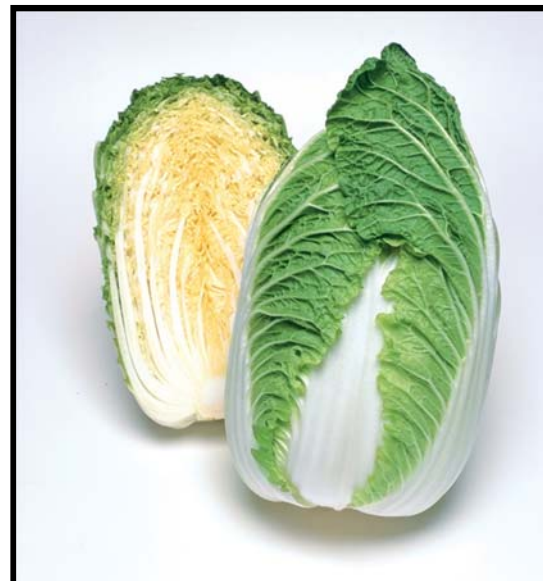


# Hybrid Chinese Cabbage Spring Crisp



DESCRIPTION:	Spring Crisp has a weight of approximately 5.0 lb (2.3 kg). Dark green external color, bright yellow internal color. Suitable for harvest spring to summer.
MATURITY:	Approximately 63 days after sowing
VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:	This early maturing variety has good field holding ability with an intermediate resistance to Clubroot.
ADAPTABILITY:	California

## FEATURES

- Excellent field holding
- Intermediate resistance to Clubroot

## BENEFITS

- Harvest flexibility
- Reduced pesticide use

Note: Chinese Cabbage requires vernalization. Bud differentiation and bolting results from low temperatures of 5°C for a week or 10°C for two weeks. For spring harvest, transplant seedlings with 5-7 true leaves raised at 23-24°C during the day and over 12°C at night. Providing plants with adequate water and fertilizer after transplanting will promote faster growth.
