

Hybrid Honeydew Melon Sweet Peridot (H6040)



DESCRIPTION: Main season green flesh Honeydew melon for the San Joaquin Valley. Consistent round shapes, smooth milky white skin, with a small seed cavity. Firmness 6 – 7.5 psi, Brix 14 – 16%.

MATURITY: Main season California 102 - 97 days

COMPARABLE VARIETIES: Summer Dew, Sofia, Vanessa, AC 252

CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS: Sweet Peridot will express less sugar net. Fruit size class 5 & 6, high yield – fruit set, during the main season and is resistant to Fusarium race 0 & 2, with intermediate resistance to Powdery mildew, strong against sulfur.
