COLOR: Bright emerald green grass-like foliage  
SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 8 inches / hardy perennial  
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Elegant, symmetrical tufts  
MARKET USE: Excellent for landscape, and for containers (indoor and out)

**CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:**

CONTAINER SIZE: SOWING: 512 or larger cell tray, multiple sow  
FINISH CONTAINER: Packs, quart, 4" pot, and gallon  
PLUG STAGE: GERMINATION: Emergence 7- 10 days / 64 - 72°F, light required  
PLUG FINISH TIME: 5- 6 weeks  
FINISHING: TRANSPLANT: 1 plant per container  
DAYS TO FLOWER: Insignificant flower  
TEMPERATURE: 58 - 60°F average temperature  
GARDEN: Prefers full sun and well drained conditions

NOTES:

- Withstands low-light conditions and a wide range of temperatures
- Multiple sowing (3 to 5 seeds per cell) shortens finish time, green packs in as little as 12 to 14 weeks
- Long lived and easily maintained
