



# Hybrid Onion Ascent (T801)



**DESCRIPTION:** Extra early, long day, Northeastern type

**MATURITY:** Early maturing (80-85 days)

**COMPARABLE VARIETIES:** Alpine class, but earlier

**VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:** This early Northeastern type is new and has shown good pack outs and earliness. Ascent's extra-early maturity makes it ideal for many northern, long-day areas. Bulbs are flat bottom shaped with good uniformity for shape and size. Ascent is best for transplant programs. Best results obtained under irrigation.

**MARKETS:** Best suited for fresh and short storage markets.

**ADAPTABILITY:** Canada, Pacific Northwest and Northeastern, long-day areas
