

Hybrid Tuscan Type Melon Fantasista (E-1006)



DESCRIPTION:	Main-season Tuscan-type melon which is oval, with a gray-green skin that turns to a pale sand color when mature. The flesh is deep orange in color with a sweet flavor. Fantasista's brix usually measures between 12 to 14% with a firmness of 5 to 6 psi.
MATURITY:	Main season, 70 to 75 days after sowing
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Proteo, Caldeo
CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS:	Fantasista has a vigorous plant producing uniform fruit with high yields. Resistant to Fusarium race 0 & 2 and intermediate resistance to Powdery Mildew.
