

Hybrid Chinese Cabbage Blues



DESCRIPTION:	Extra slow bolting, moderate head height, medium green outer leaves, white interior with head weight of approximately 4.5 lbs., barrel-shaped Napa type
MATURITY:	Extra early, approximately 57 days after sowing
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Optico
VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:	This variety has good resistance to virus, Downy mildew, and Bacterial soft rot. Recommended for summer to early winter harvest. Blues is very well suited to areas where bolting is a problem.
ADAPTABILITY:	Most North American growing areas

Note: Chinese Cabbage requires vernalization. Bud differentiation and bolting results from low temperatures of 5°C for a week or 10°C for two weeks. For spring harvest, transplant seedlings with 5-7 true leaves raised at 23-24°C during the day and over 12°C at night. Providing plants with adequate water and fertilizer after transplanting will promote faster growth.
