Carex flagellifera



COLOR: Foliar grass plant with bronze-red leaves
SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 14 inches / hardy perennial
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Broad bronze-red leaves in arching clumps
MARKET USE: Excellent for landscape, containers, and low maintenance gardens

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE: SOWING: 200 - 128 cell tray, multiple sow for best plug
FINISH CONTAINER: Quart, 6" pot, gallon and larger
PLUG STAGE: GERMINATION: Emergence 4 - 5 weeks / 64 - 72°F, do not cover seed
FINISHING: TRANSPLANT: One per quart, 1 to 3 per gallon
TEMPERATURE: 70 - 75°F average temperature
GARDEN: Grow in sun to part shade in a well-drained location

- Best sow dates are November to March, for late spring sales sow in December or January
