COLOR:	Foliar grass plant with pale green, silvery foliage
SIZE/PLANT HABIT:	Height: 10 inches / hardy evergreen perennial, USDA 7 to 10
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:	Clumping sedge forms rounded tufts of soft grey foliage, each leaf having a distinctive curling twist at its tip
MARKET USE:	Excellent for landscape, containers, and low maintenance gardens

FINISH CONTAINER:	Quart, 6" pot, gallon and larger
PLUG STAGE:	
GERMINATION:	Emergence 2 - 5 weeks / 70 - 72°F, do not cover seed
FINISHING:	
TRANSPLANT:	6 to 7 weeks after sowing from plug
DAYS TO FINISH AFTER SOWING:	140 – 168 days
TEMPERATURE:	70 - 75°F average temperature
GARDEN:	Grow in sun to part shade in a well-drained location
NOTES:	
•	For late spring sales sow in December or January
