Lobelia erinus



COLORS AVAILABLE:	Blue, Blue with Eye, Lavender, Sky Blue, White
SIZE/PLANT HABIT:	4" – 6" in height, mounding habit
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:	Annual, very early flowering (4 to 6 days earlier than Riviera)
MARKET USE:	Bedding, pack sales; great in combination plantings, excellent as a garden border

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE	
SOWING:	288 – 512 tray
FINISH CONTAINER:	Packs, 4" pots, multiples in 6" pots, combinations
PLUG STAGE:	
GERMINATION:	Emergence 14-20 days at 70-80°F no cover, usually multiple seeds sown per sell (3-5)
EC (POUR THRU METHOD)	Emergence to cotyledon expansion = 0.5-0.75 mS/cm Cotyledon expansion to true leaf stage = 0.75-1.25 mS/cm
PLUG FINISH TIME:	6-7 weeks in a 288 tray
FINISHING:	
TRANSPLANT:	35-45 days after sowing
DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER SOWING:	60 – 75 days
TEMPERATURE:	60- 70°F day / 45- 55°F night
EC:	1.75 - 3.0 mS/cm (pour thru method)
pH:	5.5 - 6.0
COMMON DIESEAS/PESTS:	Whitefly

NOTES:

- Plants need cool temperatures for best flowering
- For best results sow 4-7 seeds per cell in plug tray, transplant as one clump
- Lavender tends to have a slightly more trailing habit
- For holding and shipping of plugs, temperature should be between 36-45°F
