Hybrid Onion Rio Dulce

DESCRIPTION:	Mid-early, short-day season Grano onion. Low pungency, sizing mostly Jumbo and Colossal (3.5" – 4"), good skin retention. Highly adaptable variety.
MATURITY	Mid-early maturity
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Marlin, Madeline, Gabriella, Sweet Sunrise
CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS:	Strong tops, medium small necks, high field tolerance to Pink Root. Good bolt tolerance, vigorous root system. Globed, flat – globed shapes will vary by region. Center cuts 80%+, will vary by region.
MARKETS:	Fresh market, process mechanical harvest
ADAPTABILITY:	Texas – Rio Grande Valley; California – Imperial Valley; Georgia (processing market); Mexico – Tampico, Chihuahua, Bajillo; Guatemala
