Petunia F1 Opera Supreme™ Series

Petunia x hybrida

COLORS AVAILABLE: Blue, Lavender, Lemon, Lilac Ice, Pink Morn (AAS winner), Purple, Purple Vein, Raspberry Ice, Red, Rose, White

GARDEN SIZE/TYPE: Height 6 – 10 inches, Width 3.5 – 4.0 feet / trailing

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Excellent trailing habit, strong stems, high flower count over entire plant, excellent vigor

MARKET USE: Mixed container, hanging basket, great garden and landscape performer, spring and summer sales

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 288 – 512 tray

FINISH CONTAINER: 4-inch and 6-inch pot, hanging basket, large containers

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 4 – 7 days, 72 – 76°F, leave seed uncovered. Seed must be near saturation for good germination. Once emergence has occurred lower both temperature (65°F - 68°F) and moisture.

EC (POUR THRU METHOD)

 Emergence to cotyledon expansion = 0.8 – 1.0 mS/cm
 Cotyledon expansion to plug finish = 1.0 -1.25 mS/cm
 Plug finish = 1.25 -1.75 mS/cm

PLUG FINISH TIME:

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 25 – 35 days after sowing

DAYS TO FLOWER: 65 – 75 days

TEMPERATURE: 60 – 70°F days , 55 – 60°F nights

EC: 1.75 - 3.25 mS/cm (pour thru method)

pH: 5.5 - 6.0

COMMON DISEASE/PESTS: Botrytis, mildew/Thrips, aphids, leaf rollers

NOTES:

- Plants require a minimum of 11.5 hours of daylength to initiate flowering
- Short internodes when compared to other trailing type petunias
