

# Petunia F1 Trilogy Series

*Petunia hybrida*



**COLORS:** White, Blue, Purple, Purple Vein, Lavender Pink, Scarlet, Pink Lips, Lime, Silver Blotch, Custom Mix, July Mix; *Newest colors:* Cherry Morn (pictured), Rose Gen 2

**GARDEN SIZE:** Height: 10 to 12 inches (25.4 to 30.5 cm); Width: 24 to 30 inches (61.0 to 76.2 cm)

**NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:** Dome habit (tighter than comparisons Easy Wave, Plush and Ramblin' series), Prolific flowering on compact plants, long shelf life (retains short internodes even after blooming), less sensitive to daylength than existing spreading Petunias

**MARKET USE:** Hanging baskets, containers, garden beds

## CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS

### PLUG STAGE

**SOWING:** 288 - 512 tray

**GERMINATION:** 4 - 7 days / 72 - 76°F (22.2° - 24.4°C), leave seed uncovered, soil must be near saturation for good germination. Once emergence occurs, lower both temperature (65 to 68°F/18.3 to 20.0°C) and moisture content.

**EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD):** Emergence to cotyledon expansion = 0.5 - 0.75 mS/cm  
Cotyledon expansion to plug finish = 0.5 - 0.75 mS/cm  
Plug finish 1.0 - 1.5 mS/cm

### FINISHING

**TRANSPLANT:** 20 to 30 days after sowing

**SOW TO FLOWER:** 8 - 10 weeks

**TEMPERATURE:** 60 - 70°F (15.5 - 21.1°C) day / 55 - 60°F (12.7 - 15.5°C) nights

**EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD):** 1.2 - 2.0 mS/cm

**pH:** 5.8 - 6.2

**COMMON DISEASES/PESTS:** Botrytis, Rhizoctania/Aphids

### NOTES:

- Cold growing will keep plants compact but will also delay flower initiation
