COLORS:	Single: Cherry, Orange, Rose, White, Yellow Double: Orange (Fleuroselect Novelty), Rose (Fleuroselect Novelty), Scarlet (Fleuroselect Gold Medal), White, Yellow, Formula Mix
FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE:	Garden height: 7.8 to 14 inches (19.8 to 35.5 cm) / width: 12 to 18 inches (30.5 to 48.7 cm) Quart pot height: 6 to 8 inches (15.2 to 20.3 cm) / width: 9 to 12 inches (22.9 to 30.5 cm)
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:	Compact, good branching habit, early flowering, heat tolerant
MARKET USE:	Bedding, mass plantings, mixed containers, summer sales

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS

PLUG STAGE

SOWING: 200 tray, cover with a thin layer of fine-grade vermiculite, light not required for germination

GERMINATION: 5 - 7 days / 68 - 77°F (20 - 25°C), days, 64°F (16°C) nights
higher temperatures will reduce germination and cause weak seedlings

EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD): Emergence 0.5 - 1.0 mS/cm

PLUG FINISH: 3 - 4 weeks in 200 tray

FINISHING

TRANSPLANT: 3 to 4 weeks after sowing

TRANSPLANT TO FINISH: 8 - 9 weeks (Spring), 5 - 6 weeks (Summer)

TEMPERATURE: 65 - 80°F (18 - 27°C) days / above 60°F (15°C) nights

EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD): 1.0 - 1.5 mS/cm

pH: 5.5 - 6.2

COMMON DISEASES/PESTS: Alternaria leaf spot, botrytis, bacterial leaf spot, powdery mildew/Aphids, thrips, whitefly

NOTES:

- Belize is a free branching, naturally compact series, use discretion before applying a PGR
- Plants require good air circulation
- Southern states can grow Zinnia for year-round sales
